<p>Up to now we have used the Resource Identifier having the form <a href="http://www.cnr.it/prodotto/i/[[ID]]">http://www.cnr.it/prodotto/i/[[ID]]</a> to point to the record in People by using the string "CNR People" into every Open Portal product page.</p> <p>It seems thaat with the release of CNR_OAPub this approach is no longer working. Although the metadata records we harvest continue to have among the identifiers those existing before</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• these identifiers are no longer active (we where checking whether this is a malfunction or the previous identifiers have to be dismissed);</li><li>• new identifiers having the form <a href="https://publications.cnr.it/doc/[[ID]]">https://publications.cnr.it/doc/[[ID]]</a> start being added to the records;</li></ul> <p>I would suggest modifying our products page thus to use</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• CNR_OAPub (instead of CNR People) as the name of the repository;</li><li>• the identifiers having the form <a href="https://publications.cnr.it/doc/[[ID]]">https://publications.cnr.it/doc/[[ID]]</a></li></ul>
